This year's international initiative in support of lawyers persecuted for their professional duties focuses on Turkey, where lawyers who defend and promote fundamental rights - especially the right of defense - are subject to harassment, threats, intimidation, violence, arbitrary arrests, as well as trials without any right of defense.
